

Skate Park Rules

SKATE PARK HOURS ARE FROM DAWN TO DUSK DAILY WEATHER PERMITTING

- Use of the skate park is at your own risk.
 Winchester Parks and Recreation (or City of Winchester) does not assume responsibility for injuries.
- No trespassing or loitering when the skate park is closed.
- Helmets and closed toe shoes are strongly recommended.
- Youth under 12 must be under the direct supervision of an adult.
- Only skateboards, inline skates, scooters, and bicycles without pegs are allowed in the skate park. Motorized vehicles of any kind are prohibited.
- Alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco products, profanity, offensive conduct, violence, or other disturbances of the peace are not permitted. Amplified sound is not permitted without prior written approval.
- Weather conditions such as rain, snow, or ice can affect ramps and surface conditions resulting in unsafe conditions. Please vacate area if unsafe conditions exist.
- Graffiti, stickers, wax, chalk, and other forms of vandalism are prohibited.
- Place trash in designated trash cans. No glass containers.
- Animals are not permitted on the skate pad. (exceptions for service animals)
- All organized events must have written approval from the Winchester Parks and Recreation Department.
- The City reserves the right to close the skate park if/when needed.

The City of Winchester Parks and Recreation Department and the Winchester Police Department patrol this area. Call 911 for emergencies or 540-662-4131 for the Winchester Police Department's non-emergency line. Any violation of State law, City ordinances or park rules may result in being banned from future use of the skate park.
